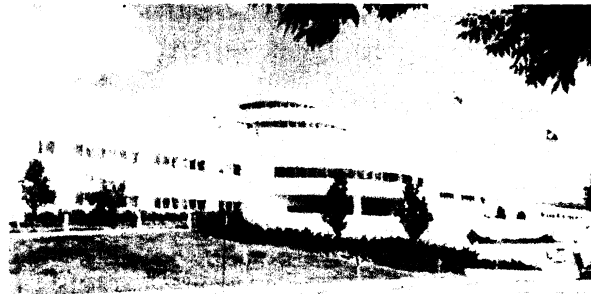

# **Homeless Program Services**

### **What we do...**

Eligible homeless veterans with mental health or addiction issues are offered help in returning to a productive life.

### **Who is eligible...**

All veterans who are "other than dishonorably" discharged from active duty and are homeless or in danger of becoming homeless should apply. Each homeless veteran who meets the eligibility criteria will be considered for VA Homeless Program assistance. Veterans must have sobriety and be able and willing to work.

### **How to apply ...**

Veterans may request assistance Monday through Friday during regular clinic hours at Tennessee Valley Healthcare System Nashville location. Appointments must be made for services at the Alvin C. York location. Our outreach social workers also assist homeless veterans in the local community during our scheduled outreach clinics at various homeless kitchens or other assistance centers.

### **Brief program description...**

#### **1. The Healthcare for Homeless Veterans Program or HCHV**

This provides assistance to homeless veterans seeking healthcare through Tennessee Valley Healthcare System. Our social work team will assist veterans in obtaining healthcare appointments.

#### **2. The Grant and Per Diem Program or G&PD**

This provides recovering veterans with a substance abuse history or mental health issues, the opportunity to move into one of 4 VA supported halfway house programs in the community. These 4 programs assist with housing, employment, as well as aftercare support. It should be noted that each program sets the rules and regulations for their own houses and will not tolerate behavior that has a negative impact on your success or the success of other veterans in the program.

*\*House rules will be provided upon admission.*

The G&PD program provides to each eligible veteran either three placement opportunities or twenty four months of assistance in a lifetime.

#### **3. The Veteran's Administration Supported Housing Program or VASH**

This is the final phase of homeless program assistance. Veterans who meet eligibility requirements for both the MDHA program and HUD assistance may also meet VASH program eligibility requirements. These veterans will be provided, when available, with HUD vouchers to assist with monthly rent. The veterans who receive MDHA/HUD vouchers will also receive VASH case management services.

### **Additional information...**

Homeless Clinics are located on the 4<sup>th</sup> Floor of the TVHS Nashville location. The clinics are staffed by Homeless Program social workers, who are available to assist with questions and take applications for housing and medical assistance. Clinic Hours are Monday mornings and Tuesday - Friday afternoons.
