



Biographical Information – Jin H. Han, MD, MSc

Jin H. Han has been an assistant professor with the Department of Emergency Medicine at Vanderbilt University since 2005. He completed his emergency medicine residency at the University of Cincinnati and also served as a chief resident. He recently completed a research fellowship and obtained a Masters in Clinical Epidemiology. In addition to his clinical responsibilities in the emergency department, Dr. Han has been very active in patient oriented research. He has published over 20 peer-reviewed scientific manuscripts, 10 of which he has first authored. In addition, he has made numerous abstract presentations at both emergency medicine and geriatric national meetings. He is also the recipient of the Vanderbilt Physician Scientist Development Grant.

Dr. Han's long-term mission is to improve the quality of care delivered to the older emergency department patient. Specifically, his research focuses on studying the effects of delirium in the older emergency department and how it affects patient outcomes and resource utilization. He is also studying ways to improve delirium detection in a challenging emergency department environment.
