



Biographical Information – H. Keipp Talbot, MD

Dr. H. Keipp Talbot is an Assistant Professor of Medicine at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. She completed her residency in internal medicine in 2003, a fellowship in infectious diseases in 2006, and a Masters in Public Health in 2007, all at Vanderbilt. She works with both the Vanderbilt Vaccine Research Program and the Center for Quality Aging to evaluate vaccine efficacy in older adults. She has been funded by the NIH, the CDC, and by industry. .

Research interests:

Dr. Talbot's research experience has included reverse genetics and molecular epidemiology of coronaviruses in two different virology labs and has participated in vaccine clinical trials, including studies of two H5N1 influenza vaccines and two inter-pandemic seasonal influenza vaccines for licensure. Her primary research interests are examining the burden of respiratory illnesses, vaccine efficacy, and correlates of immunity in older adults with a special interest in influenza.
