CRIME ALERT – Attempted Robbery Off Campus

On August 21, 2009 at approximately 1:37 pm, Vanderbilt Police Department received a report of an attempted robbery behind Pizza Perfect at 1602 21st Ave South. An employee of Pizza Perfect stated he was approached in the back parking lot by a male and female asking for money. According to the victim, the male displayed two hand guns concealed under his jacket in his waistband. The victim said that he wrestled with the male, and caused the suspect to drop the guns. Both suspects ran to a red late model maroon station wagon, possibly a Malibu, and headed east in the alley towards 19th Avenue South.

Suspect description:

Suspect #1: Male black, 5' 7", 170 pounds, approximately 25 years old, dark wavy hair. Wearing a dark suit jacket and a black t-shirt with white design.

Suspect #2: Female black, 5'4" approximately 20 years old, medium build, with braids, and acne or scarring on her face.
